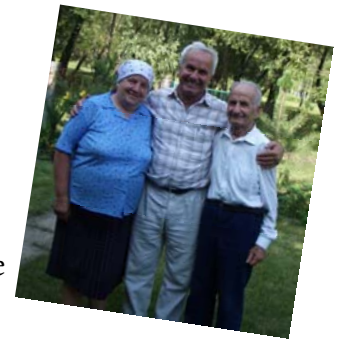

Plans for a June trip are taking shape to continue the support for Pastor Alexander and the Gethsemane Baptist Church, the children and women at the cancer hospital, Costesti and other orphanages, Brenzini Institute for the mentally and physically handicapped, and the elderly, poor and sick.
