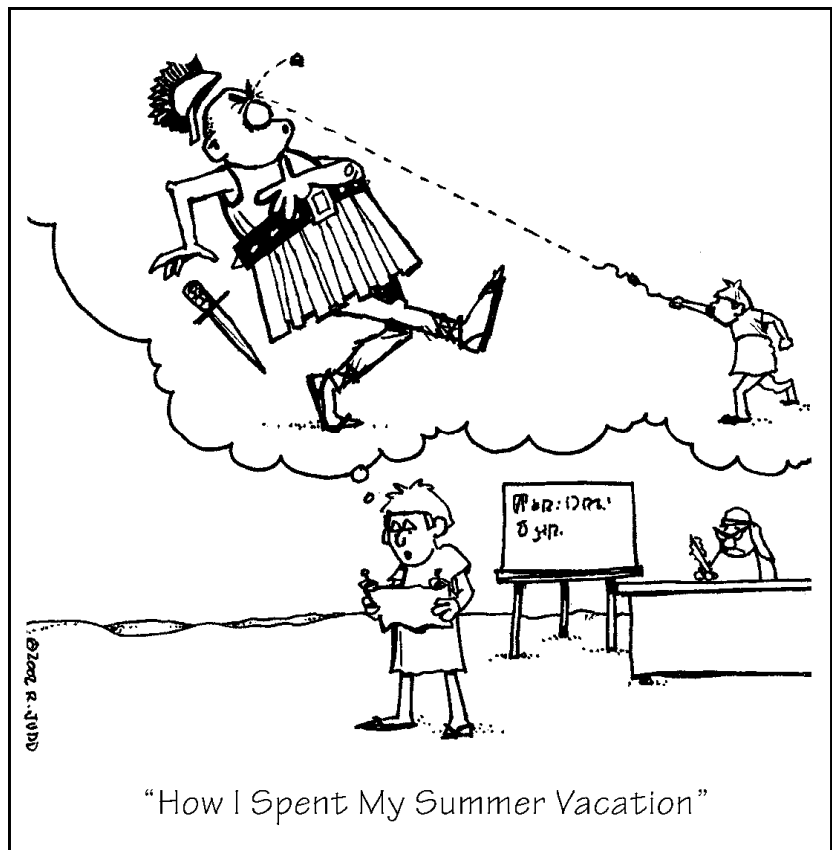

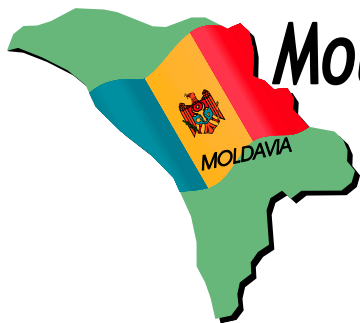
Deacon Nominees
