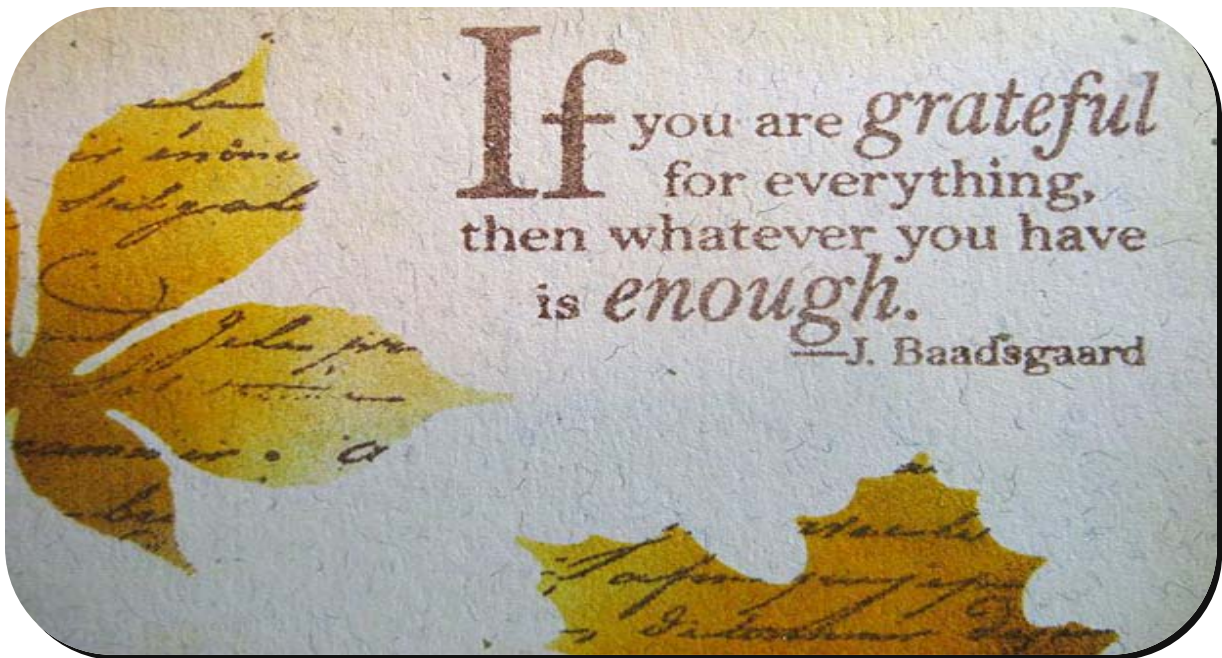
Samaritan's Purse Shoeboxes
