Senior Adults

Be a joy to that dear old man...He once was as young as you are; he once had the vigour that you have. Console him, cheer him, give him the respect that is due to his many years. Do not let him feel that you consider him an old fogey who lingers, superfluous, on the stage; but learn from his experience, imitate his perseverance, and ask God to be with you in your old age, as he is with him.

Middle-Age and Young Adults

...those in middle life...They are working hard, bearing the burden and heat of the day; as yet their bones are full of marrow, and they are strong men ready for service for the Lord. Seek to sustain their hands in every possible way. Help them all you can. Get closer to one another, and fill up the vacant spaces that death's arrows continue to make in our ranks.

Youth and Children

Specially, however, I want to speak to you about serving your own generation in the part that is rising; the young people who are like the sun in the east, as yet scarcely above the horizon. This part of our generation is specially the care of parents and Sunday-school teachers; but let us not leave it entirely to them. We can, most of us, do something to serve this portion of our generation before we fall asleep. Beloved, I commend to your care and attention the children and young people who abound in our midst. In them lies our hope for the future of God's cause on earth.

As we set our feet into October, let us fix our hopes firmer on Jesus and our attitudes firmer on honoring him and our actions firmer on serving those of all ages. By the grace of God, the people of Holland Avenue are truly and joyfully growing in not demanding our own way, but in serving and loving one another in the same way we want to be served and loved.
