Maybe your "phone" is soap operas or the internet or romance novels or talk radio or gossip over the back fence. Whatever your "phone" is, find a way to turn it off so you can be "bored" for a little bit. It might release you to notice others and love others and serve others.

It might also release you to notice the One who loved you and gave Himself up for you! Noticing Him more is a sure cure for the potential of a boring summer or a wasted life!
