B.B. Webb was sitting in a radio station in Arlington, Virginia. He leaned into a mouthpiece and said one word. About 3,800 miles away through an antenna on top of the Eiffel Tower two engineers that worked for the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, H.E. Shreeve and A.M. Curtis, heard Webb's one word: "Hello."

Julia Zorthian of Time Magazine notes that on that October day 102 years ago human speech did something it had never done before: cross the Atlantic Ocean.

Webb said a few more words into that mouthpiece that the engineers could understand and finally they heard: "Goodbye, Shreeve."

She was leaning inside a burial vault wrapped in grief because it seemed as if someone had stolen the body of her loved One.

Moments later she heard one word.

It is impossible to determine how many miles that one word travelled. Technically, that word began in heaven and then made its way to a stable in Bethlehem and then descended into the deepest caves of death and then astoundingly rose back up to earth and now this distraught woman could clearly hear that one word: "Mary."

Jesus of Nazareth, the Christ, had conquered the grave and wanted his friend Mary to know that she had nothing to fear or be distraught over because death had lost and love had won.

And Jesus did not sign off with "goodbye". He simply guaranteed that he would come again. In other words, the "hello" of Jesus never ends.
